Banding and Setting

- Your child will be placed in a specific set within a Band;
- This placement will allow the Academy to guide your child along an appropriate learning journey;
- This placement will provide work programmes which, whilst accessible and tailored to need, will also stretch them to achieve a higher level of understanding;
- No matter their Band/Set all students will enjoy six lessons per day with all core subjects covered across a 30 period week
- All students study a core of Maths, English and Science.

Our curriculum design is flexible to allow for depth and development in personalised learning and it is structured to facilitate a smooth transition to the A level courses available in our Sixth Form.

Assessment Procedures

The Academy operates a rigorous and thorough assessment process in order to monitor student progress and identify learner needs.

- Students are formally assessed via a series of 'Progress Points' throughout the year; the results of which are reported to home.
- Informal assessment via classwork and homework is ongoing in all subjects.
- Further details regarding the assessment procedures will be given during the first weeks of the Autumn Term.



Learning Support

The Academy SENDCo is Dani Parker, Vice Principal and a member of the Leadership Team.

Support is tailored by the SENDCo to address identified needs which includes:

- Individual teaching
- Small group, individual and paired reading
- Literacy & Numeracy support
- Specific in-class support
- Access to counselling and the Academy Chaplain
- Academic tutorial



Rewards and Sanctions

- Students in the Academy receive **Merits** for their efforts and work. These are recorded in the student's planners alongside other information relating to progress.
- Students are also awarded certificates and gift vouchers for outstanding effort and work.
- We will communicate information about both rewards and sanctions via a letter to your home address.

Care & Guidance

We are very proud of our pastoral system which is overseen by a Vice Principal and is based on a vertical tutoring system.

All students are allocated to a House, each with:

- An Assistant Principal as a Head of House
- Two Senior Prefects who will support the Head of House.
- 14 Tutor Groups:
 - each with a House Tutor;
 - Each with a House Prefect;
 - Each with 5/6 students from each year.



Pastoral Structure


Students are proud to be members of our 6 Houses, each of which are named after constellations:

Attendance

- Parents/carers are asked to telephone the Academy every day their child is absent or use the MyEd app to contact us.
- We require a note for our records upon their return.
- Parents and carers will be notified by text or email if students are absent without a reason.
- If your child has a medical appointment please provide evidence.
- A Leave of Absence will only be granted in very exceptional circumstances.
- Government expectation of attendance is 95% or above which we monitor and promote in the Academy.



Cashless Catering



- The Academy has a cashless catering system.
- Parents will receive a letter containing instructions on how to set up their Parent Pay account, payment methods available and an option to choose the thumb print system which will require the return of the biometrics consent form.
- This system enables parents and carers to see what their child is buying for lunch, top up their child's accounts and monitor what they are spending.
- Students can also top up their own account, which uses an individual thumbprint or code on machines situated within the Academy.



MyEd App



- The Academy has a mobile app for sharing information with parents.

- Parents can use the MyEd app to view their child's attendance, timetable and messages from the Academy or it can be used to contact us.



How You Can Help

- Please help your child to be organised.
- Please check and sign their Planner on a weekly basis.
- Ensure they have a place to keep their books and a homework routine.
- Encourage them to pack their schoolbag the previous evening for the next day.
- Please ensure that they are punctual to the Academy.



Health and Safety

- Please can all parents be aware that there is no access for parental vehicles on the Academy site for dropping off or picking up students.
- Rules of the Highway Code Yellow Box
 Junction, must be adhered to please. You MUST
 NOT enter the box until your exit road or lane is
 clear.
- Please do not turn around or stop in the Academy Entrance or Exit.

- Under NO circumstances do we allow students to have Mobile Phones in their possession on site.
